RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1374 S-2000

A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P182,000.00) OR SO MUCH THEREOF, TO PROVIDE IMMEDIATE RELIEF ASSISTANCE TO THE VICTIMS OF FIRE CONSISTING OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY SEVEN (57) HOUSE-OWNERS AND SIXTY-EIGHT (68) HOUSE-RENTERS/SHARERS, AT STO. NINO STREET, BARANGAY SAN ANTONIO, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, THE NECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR TO BE TAKEN FROM GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS OR FROM ANY OTHER AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY.


WHEREAS, a fire occurred at Sto. Nino Street, Barangay San Antonio, District I, Quezon City, at around 7:00 p.m. last November 21, 1999, affecting Fifty Seven (57) house-owners and One Hundred Twelve (112) house-renters/sharers;

WHEREAS, these unfortunate fire victims need the help and assistance of the City government in the form of material assistance, such as building materials for the reconstruction of their houses, purchase of food, clothing, etc., in the amount of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) for each house-owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) for each house-renter/sharer;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to allocate, as it does hereby allocate, One Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand Pesos (P182,000.00) or so much thereof, to provide immediate relief assistance to the victims of fire consisting of Fifty-Seven (57) house-owners and Sixty-Eight (68) house-renters/sharers, at Sto. Nino Street, Barangay San Antonio, District I, Quezon City, the necessary funds therefor to be taken from Grants, Subsidies and Contributions or from any other available funds in the City Treasury.
