RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1380 S-2000

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO GLOBE TELECOM, INC., FOR THE CONSTRUCTION/ERECTION OF A CELL SITE AT B. SOLIVEN AVE., COMMONWEALTH HEIGHTS SUBDIVISION, BARANGAY COMMONWEALTH, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, petitioner Globe Telecom, Inc. is an operator of a telecommunication services network;

WHEREAS, petitioner Globe Telecom, Inc. is on an expansion program of its telecommunication network facilities particularly in Quezon City, and has identified an area wherein its cell site will be located;

WHEREAS, petitioner Globe Telecom, Inc. has applied with the Quezon City Council for the issuance of a Special Use Permit as required by Ordinance No. SP-22, S-92, otherwise known as the "Quezon City Zoning Ordinance of 1992" and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;

WHEREAS, it is to the public interest that the improvement, modernization and expansion of telecommunication facilities particularly in Quezon City are encouraged.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the issuance of a Special Use Permit to petitioner Globe Telecom, Inc., for the construction/erection of a cell site at B. Soliven Ave., Commonwealth Heights Subdivision, Brgy. Commonwealth, Quezon City; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that petitioner Globe Telecom, Inc. shall bear the exclusive responsibility for the sound maintenance of such facilities; PROVIDED, FURTHER, that the petitioner shall guarantee that no interference with or damage to local appliances or other properties will likely result therefrom.
