A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO PTT PHILIPPINES, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A GASOLINE SERVICE STATION AT REGALADO AVENUE, FAIRVIEW, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, petitioner PTT Philippines, Inc. is embarking on an expansion of its filling stations and has identified a certain area in Quezon City where one of its gasoline service stations will be located;

WHEREAS, petitioner PTT Philippines Inc. has requested the Quezon City Council for the issuance of a Special Use Permit for the construction of the above-stated gasoline service station particularly at:


NOW, THEREFORE,
