RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1392, S-2000

A RESOLUTION URGING HIS HONOR ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR., CITY MAYOR, TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF THE LATE PO1 RICHARD CABATAC FROM THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT, STATION 11, WHO WAS KILLED IN A SHOOTOUT WITH ROBBERS AT THE GALAS PUBLIC MARKET IN QUEZON CITY, IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT UNDER ITEM GRANTS, AIDS AND CONTRIBUTIONS, OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR.

WHEREAS, last May 15, 1999, at Barangay San Isidro Galas, District IV, and around 6:30 P.M., Thursday, PO1 Richard Cabatac from the Central Police District Command, was shot to death by a group of robbers, after responding to a call of duty, together with other six members of the police force assigned at CPD Station 11;

WHEREAS, such act of bravery and gallantry is a clear manifestation of the victim's readiness to serve, and willingness to risk his life when the need arises to protect the life, limbs and property of person/s or the general public, in accordance with his oath of office and sacred duty;

WHEREAS, no such amount of money can equate such heroic act or can lessen the feeling of sadness, now being experienced by the family for the untimely loss of their dearest one and may be a gesture of sympathy from the local government officials of Quezon City, is quite enough to show concern and admiration.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urged, His Honor Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., City Mayor, to grant financial assistance to the bereaved family of the late PO1 Richard Cabatac from the Central Police District Command, Station 11, who was killed in a shootout with robbers at the Galas Public Market in Quezon City, in the amount of Thirty Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00) which shall be taken from the Annual Budget of the Quezon City government under item Grants, Aids and Contributions, Office of the City Mayor.
