RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1402, S-2000

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE VICTIMS OF THE FIRE ON JUNE 5, 2000, INVOLVING SOME TWO THOUSAND (2,000) FAMILIES AT SSS GARDEN, BARANGAY PINYAHAN, QUEZON CITY, AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY-OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER AND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P500.00) PER FAMILY SHARER, WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE GRANTS, AIDS AND CONTRIBUTIONS FROM THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE AND UNALLOCATED SOURCE OF FUND IN THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, a fire razed the houses of some two thousand (2,000) families in the SSS Garden, Barangay Pinyahan, in the morning of June 5, 2000;

WHEREAS, most families totally lost all personal belongings, including clothings, appliances, cash and some valuables, aside from their homes, resulting in a worst kind of deprivation;


WHEREAS, the City government in its avowed responsibility to care for its constituents could lessen the blow of this tragedy on these fire victims by providing urgently needed financial assistance;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to extend, as it does hereby extend, financial assistance to the victims of the fire on June 5, 2000, involving some two thousand (2,000) families at SSS Garden, Barangay Pinyahan, Quezon City, at Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) per family-owner and one thousand pesos (P1,000.00) per family renter and Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) per family sharer, which shall be taken from the grants, aids and contributions from the Annual Budget of the City government or from any available and unallocated source of fund in the City Treasury.
