A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR., QUEZON CITY, TO EXTEND BURIAL AND/OR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO ALL DULY IDENTIFIED BONAFIDE RESIDENTS/VICTIMS IN THE PAYATAS DUMPSITE CALAMITY ON JULY 10, 2000 CHARGEABLE AGAINST ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2000, a large portion of the mountain of garbage and mud at the Payatas Dumpsite, Quezon City, collapsed and fell on several shanties below, thus, killing and injuring a number of people;

WHEREAS, the incident was caused by the week-long rain brought about by typhoons Edeng and Ditang, which loosened the earth and pile of garbage, hence, causing them to collapse and blanketing several shanties of informal settlers;

WHEREAS, a fire broke out at the site, which is possibly caused by the methane gas emanating from the pile of garbage, leaving several families homeless;

WHEREAS, in order to alleviate their sufferings, it is proper that the victims be extended burial and/or medical assistance by the city government;

WHEREAS, the beneficiaries will be based on the list of the Social Services Development Department (SSDD);


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Honorable City Mayor, Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., Quezon City, to extend burial and/or medical assistance to all duly identified bonafide residents/victims in the Payatas dumpsite calamity on July 10, 2000, chargeable against any available funds in the City Treasury.
