RESOLUTION NO. ~~SP-422~~ S-2000

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING ALL COMPONENT BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY TO ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT GARBAGE SEGREGATION, COMPOSTING, RECYCLING AND SUCH OTHER SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS.

Introduced by Councilor ALMARIO E. FRANCISCO.

Co-Introduced by Councilors Antonio L. Sioson, Elizabeth A. Delarmente, Godofredo T. Liban II, Marciano P. Medalla, Eric Z. Medina, Michael F. Planas and Bayani V. Hipol.

WHEREAS, the recent Payatas tragedy is a grim reminder to all and sundry that proper solid waste disposal is a collective responsibility of government and its constituents;

WHEREAS, as the basic independent political unit of government, the Barangay stands in the forefront of public service, such that it behooves upon it to conceptualize, initiate and implement such programs and projects that have direct impact on and address important community concerns;

WHEREAS, one such important community concern relates to proper garbage disposal and solid waste management;

WHEREAS, every component Barangay of Quezon City sets aside in its approved annual budget an amount equivalent to five percent (5%) of the total annual budget, in compliance with existing budgetary/local government directives, to be utilized exclusively for solid waste management programs and projects;

WHEREAS, with the recurring garbage disposal crisis, especially within Quezon City, on account of the permanent closure of the Payatas dumpsite, fresh initiatives must be undertaken by the Barangays to institute short-term, medium-term and long-term plans designed specifically to address this problem;

WHEREAS, accepted solutions to the problem, such as garbage segregation, composting, recycling and such other solid waste management program components, can be done efficiently and effectively at the grass roots or Barangay level, using such financial and other resources which are readily available to it;

WHEREAS, this strategy will in the long run result to cost saving measure which will redound to the best interest of the Barangays as a whole thus resulting to a sound financial position for the city;

WHEREAS, the move by the barangays to adopt and carry out related solid waste management undertakings will drastically aid the local government in solving the acute garbage accumulation and collection situation of the city.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, all component Barangays of Quezon City, to adopt and implement garbage segregation, composting, recycling and such other waste management programs and projects.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to direct, as it does hereby direct, the Barangay Operations Center, to disseminate this Resolution to every component Barangay in Quezon City, monitor its implementation, and render a periodic report thereon.
