RESOLUTION NO. SP-1446 S-2000

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE OFFICERS AND MEN OF THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT (CPD) OFFICE STATION 10 FOR THE IMMEDIATE APPREHENSION OF THE SUSPECTS IN THE KILLING OF A SECURITY GUARD IN A PAWNSHOP HEIST ALONG COMMONWEALTH AVENUE, QUEZON CITY, AND CPD STATION 6 FOR THE EARLY SOLUTION OF THE CELEBRATED SAN MATEO RAPE CASE

WHEREAS, barely two (2) hours after the March 13, 2000 heist at the Manggahan Pawnshop along Commonwealth Avenue, Quezon City, where one security guard posted in the area was killed and seven (7) suspects were nabbed by operatives of the Central Police District Office (CPDO) Station 10 while they were holding a pot session in their hideout in San Roque II, Barangay Pag-Asa, this City;

WHEREAS, excellent intelligence work and efficient surveillance procedures led to the early solution of the San Mateo rape case when one (1) of the six (6) suspects finally fell into the hands of the law for sexually abusing three (3) coeds on the banks of the Tumana River in San Mateo, Rizal, on the night of January 17, 2000;

WHEREAS, the twin successful operations speak of the professionalism and dedication to duty of the Central Police District officers and men concerned, and a reassuring whiff of fresh air to City residents every time when criminal elements are displaying callous disregard for the law;


WHEREAS, the trust and confidence conferred upon by the people of Quezon City to the Central Police District Office as their true protector deserve heartfelt congratulations and profound recognition.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to commend and congratulate, as it does hereby commend and congratulate, the officers and men of the Central Police District Office Station 10 for the immediate apprehension of the suspects in the killing of a security guard in a pawnshop heist along Commonwealth Avenue, Quezon City and CPD Station 6 for the early solution of San Mateo rape case.
