RESOLUTION NO. SP-1500, S-2000

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR., REPRESENTING QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT TO ENTER INTO A NEGOTIATED CONTRACT WITH ANY REPUTABLE CONTRACTOR FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE UNUSED BUILDING TO BE CONVERTED INTO A JAIL CENTER FOR WOMEN AT CAMP KARINGAL, SIKATUNA VILLAGE, THIS CITY.

WHEREAS, the over-crowding and congestion of inmates in our city jail has given rise to the prevalence of respiratory diseases, periodic riots/violence and even of pregnancies among some female inmates;

WHEREAS, while we are aware that the provision and maintenance of the city jail is a responsibility of the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP), the City government has always considered said inmates as part of its constituency;

WHEREAS, the BJMP, through the Honorable Secretary of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), has signified its conformity with the conversion of said building within its property at Sikatuna Village, this City, into a Jail Center for Women as proposed by His Honor, Mayor Ismael A. Mathay, Jr.;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Honorable City Mayor Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., representing Quezon City government to enter into a negotiated contract with any reputable contractor for the rehabilitation of the unused building to be converted into a Jail Center for Women at Camp Karingal, Sikatuna Village, this City.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that this Resolution shall take effect upon its approval.
