RESOLUTION NO. SP. 1 50 9- 75-2001

A RESOLUTION EXENDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO SOME FORTY (40) FAMILIES WHO WERE RENDERED HOMELESS BY A FIRE THAT HIT 736 QUEZON AVENUE. SUPERCAR, BARANGAY TATALON, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, ON JANUARY 3, 2001, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER TO BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY FUNDS OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (1) (iv) of Republic Act No. 7160, provides, to wit:

"Section 458 (a) The sangguniang panlungsod, as the legislative body of the city, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the city as provided for under Section 22 of this Code, shall:

(1) Approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective city government, and in this connection, shall:

(iv) Adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and their return to productive livelihood following said events."

WHEREAS, on January 3, 2001, at around 5:00 a.m., a fire struck at 736 Quezon Avenue, Supercar, Barangay Tatalon, District IV, Quezon City, rendering homeless some forty families;

WHEREAS, because of this unfortunate incident, our constituents need the support and assistance of the city government in this great time of need through financial assistance for the reconstruction of their houses and for food, clothing and other necessities.

NOW, THEREFORE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to extend, as it does hereby extend, financial assistance to some forty (40) families who were rendered homeless by a fire that hit 736 Quezon Avenue, Supercar, Barangay Tatalon, District IV, Quezon City, on January 3, 2001, in the amount of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) per family owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per family renter/sharer to be taken from the Calamity Funds of the City government or from any available funds in the City Treasury.
