RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1522, S-2001

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AMUSEMENT TAX EXEMPTION TO THE NEW ERA UNIVERSITY FOR HOSTING THE OPENING CEREMONIES OF THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (NCRAA) HELD LAST NOVEMBER 21, 2000 AT THE ARANETA COLISEUM.

WHEREAS, Section 192 of the Local Government Code provides that "Local Government units may, through ordinances duly approved, grant tax exemptions, incentives or reliefs under such terms and conditions as they may deem necessary."

WHEREAS, the term "as they may deem necessary" is limited by a specific provision of law allowing grants of tax exemptions which is the Quezon City Revenue Code of 1993;


WHEREAS, the said hosting of the opening ceremonies of the National Capital Region Athletic Association (NCRAA) held last November 21, 2000, falls within the allowable activities exempted by the Quezon City Revenue Code.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant as it hereby grant, amusement tax exemption to the New Era University for hosting the National Capital Region Athletic Association (NCRAA) held last November 21, 2000, at the Araneta Coliseum.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to the United Promotions, Incorporated, New Era University and the Business Permits and Licensing Office.
