A RESOLUTION URGING THE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES (TUP) TO ESTABLISH AN "EVENING OPPORTUNITY COLLEGE" (TUP-QUEZON CITY) AT THE E. RODRIGUEZ JR. HIGH SCHOOL, LOCATED IN DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Technological University of the Philippines (TUP) is a state university and was created under Presidential Decree No. 1518;

WHEREAS, the Technological University of the Philippines, as a Center of Excellence in Technical and Technological Education and Training, provides higher and advanced programs to develop globally competitive graduates for education, industry and related sectors, through instruction, research, extension and production for a sustainable future and a desired quality of life;

WHEREAS, the Technological University of the Philippines has a program called "Evening Opportunity College" that initially will offer technology courses that are needed by the industries;

WHEREAS, through an interim arrangement with the Technological University of the Philippines, the "Evening Opportunity College" (TUP-Quezon City) will be established;

WHEREAS, the "Evening Opportunity College" will make use of the facilities of an existing school, in this case, the E. Rodriguez Jr. High School located in District I of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, currently there is only one (1) Quezon City Polytechnic Training Center owned by the Quezon City Government that can only accommodate a limited number of students;

WHEREAS, through the "Evening Opportunity College" (TUP-Quezon City), the city government will be able to provide proper and well-rounded education with emphasis on technology to students at low and reasonable tuition fees;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Technological University of the Philippines (TUP) to establish an "Evening Opportunity College" (TUP-Quezon City) at the E. Rodriguez Jr. High School, located in District I of Quezon City.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished to the Technological University of the Philippines upon its approval.
