A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE WARMEST CONGRATULATIONS OF THE PEOPLE OF QUEZON CITY HEADED BY THEIR CITY OFFICIALS TO THE HONORABLE SENATOR TEOFISTO GUNGONA FOR HAVING BEEN DESIGNATED VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES.

WHEREAS, Her Excellency, President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo, has nominated Senate Minority Floor Leader Teofisto Guingona to be the Vice-President of the country.

WHEREAS, both the Senate and the House of Representatives have confirmed Mr. Guingona's nomination as Vice-President;

WHEREAS, Senator Guingona, who grew up and finished high school in Cagayan de Oro City, his family's home province, would strongly give able representation in the hierarchy of government to the people of Mindanao, where about one third of the country's population live;

WHEREAS, the life of Senator Guingona, who worked his way through law school by teaching history and political science before joining the government in various distinguished political positions, would be a shining model for the youth who hunger for inspiration from today's leaders;

WHEREAS, by his personal history and by his professionalism and integrity, Senator Guingona promises to be an able partner of the President in chartering a course of full development and economic progress for the country.
