A RESOLUTION URGING CONGRESS TO ENACT A BILL AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF THE OMNIBUS ELECTION CODE TO ENABLE THE COMMISSION ON ELECTION TO HOLD A SPECIAL REGISTRATION FOR THE 4.5 MILLION FILIPINOS WHO WERE NOT ABLE TO REGISTER DURING THE LAST REGISTRATION AND ALLOW THEM TO VOTE IN THE COMING MAY ELECTION.


WHEREAS, it was estimated that presently, there are about 4.5 million Filipinos who were not able to register during the special registration held in December of last year;

WHEREAS, according to some reports, most of those people were not able to register due to lack of awareness and information dissemination on the part of the COMELEC.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, Congress to enact a bill amending the Omnibus Election Code to enable the Commission on Election to hold a special registration that will allow the 4.5 million Filipinos to register and vote in the coming election.
