RESOLUTION NO. SP-1540, S-2001

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE HONORABLE ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR., CITY MAYOR, TO INTERCEDE FOR AND IN BEHALF OF SOME MEMBERS OF THE KATIPUNAN VENDORS ASSOCIATION WITH THE METROPOLITAN WATERWORKS AND SEWERAGE SYSTEM AUTHORITIES, TO ALLOW THEM TO TEMPORARILY RECONSTRUCT THEIR BURNT STALLS/ ESTABLISHMENTS AT THE BURNT SITE AND CONTINUE THEIR VENDING ACTIVITIES, THEIR MAIN SOURCE OF LIVELIHOOD.

WHEREAS, an accidental fire occurred on March 12, 2001, at the vicinity of the Balara Filters Gate I, razing some fifteen (15) stalls/establishments to the ground;

WHEREAS, these vendors, mostly Barangay Pansol residents, have used this area for vending activities for some twenty years now wherein the MWSS and the Sangguniang Barangay have offered no objections;


WHEREAS, this burnt site would soon be part of the circumferential road (C-5), to which the vendors have agreed to voluntarily vacate the area should the proposed C-5 be finally implemented;

WHEREAS, the vendors' association had asked the help of the Pansol Sangguniang Barangay to have their stalls/establishments reconstructed and to which the MWSS authorities did not agree to during the dialogues conducted;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request, the Honorable Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., City Mayor, to intercede for and in behalf of some members of the Katipunan Vendors Association with the Metropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage System authorities, to allow them to temporarily reconstruct their burnt stalls/establishments at the burnt site and continue their vending activities, their main source of livelihood.
