RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1560, S-2001

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR., CITY MAYOR, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE YOUTH MOVEMENT ESCOPA FOUNDATION INC., (YMEFI) AND THE BARANGAY COUNCIL OF BARANGAY ESCOPA III FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A YOUTH TRAINING CENTER.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of R.A. 7160 mandates local government units to "encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities...";

WHEREAS, Section 458, No. 5 (x) of the same law further provides that local sanggunians by ordinance, shall "Subject to the availability of funds and to existing laws, rules and regulations, establish and provide for the operation of vocational and technical schools and similar post-secondary institution...";

WHEREAS, the Youth Movement Escopa Foundation, Inc., proposes to construct a permanent training center for youths on a two hundred fifty-two (252) square meters portion of the Barangay Hall compound of Barangay Escopa III which has a total area of nine hundred seventy-five (975) square meters from a total forty-four thousand four hundred eighty six (44,486) square meters City-owned property described under Transfer Certificate of Title No. (TCT) RT 22836 (2926772);

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay Escopa III in its Resolution No. 111, Series of 1999 has endorsed the YMEFI training project proposal to the City government for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Honorable Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., City Mayor, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Youth Movement Escopa Foundation, Inc. (YMEFI) and the Barangay Council of Barangay Escopa III for the establishment of a training center for the youths at the Barangay Hall Compound.
