RESOLUTION NO. SP-1569, S-2001

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR THE DON MARIANO MARCOS AVENUE EXTENSION PROJECT, CONSTRUCTION OF A LINK ROAD BETWEEN COMMONWEALTH AVENUE AND QUIRINO HIGHWAY, EXECUTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS, REPRESENTED BY SECRETARY SIMEON B. DATUMANONG, THE METROPOLITAN MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, REPRESENTED BY CHAIRMAN BENJAMIN S. ABALOS, AND THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT REPRESENTED BY MAYOR ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR.

Introduced by Councilors GODOFREDO T. LIBAN II, EUFEMIO C. LAGUMBAY, WILMA AMORANTO-SARINO, VINCENT P. CRISOLOGO, ROMMEL R. ABESAMIS, MARCIANO P. MEDALLA, ERIC Z. MEDINA and JORGE L. BANAL.

WHEREAS, the worsening traffic condition in certain strategic alternative areas in Quezon City has been a major problem which the City government has been trying to address for so many years now;

WHEREAS, among the problem access areas already identified are those coming from Commonwealth Avenue to Novaliches passing through the Quirino Highway and vice versa;

WHEREAS, the construction of the link road for extension of Commonwealth Avenue and Quirino Highway will be undertaken by the Metro Manila Urban Transport Integration Project funded by the World Bank has been found to be a resolution to relieve congestion of traffic along the alternative routes at the vicinity and at the same time to optimize the conveyance of traffic along this vital routes:

WHEREAS, in the implementation of the project, the acquisition of the property identified as Lot No. 1112-B, (LRC) Psd-29397, described under TCT No. 215388 owned by PHINMA Property Holdings Corporation with an area of nineteen thousand (19,000) sq.m. and another property containing an area of thirteen thousand nine hundred fifty-one (13,951) sq.m. owned by J.F. Proximo Holdings and Development Corporation are necessary for a road right-of-way, whereby MMDA will pay ninety percent (90%) and the Quezon City government ten percent (10%) of the acquisition cost, hence, a Memorandum of Agreement subject matter of this resolution was executed by the parties thereto;

WHEREAS, finding the MOA to be legally in order and its application advantageous to the City government and for the general welfare of the City and its people, the ratification, therefore, has now become imperative.

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## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify, the Memorandum of Agreement for the Don Mariano Marcos Avenue Extension Project, construction of a link road between Commonwealth Avenue and Quirino Highway, executed by the Department of Public Works and Highways, represented by Secretary Simeon B. Datumanong, the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority, represented by Chairman Benjamin S. Abalos, and the Quezon City government, represented by Mayor Ismael A. Mathay, Jr.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copy of this resolution be furnished Department of Public Works and Highways, through its Secretary, Metropolitan Manila Development Authority, through its Chairman and the Quezon City government, through its Mayor, for their information and appropriate action.
