RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1579, S-2001

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO CALTEX (PHILIPPINES), INC., FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A GASOLINE SERVICE STATION ON THE LOT COVERED BY TRANSFER CERTIFICATE OF TITLE NUMBERED 368386 AND 368387 LOCATED ALONG G. ARANETA AVENUE, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, petitioner Caltex (Philippines) Inc., is embarking on an expansion of its gasoline filling stations and has requested the Quezon City Council for the issuance of a Special Use Permit for the construction of its gasoline service station on the lot covered by Transfer Certificate of Title Numbered 368386 and 368387 along G. Araneta Avenue, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the construction and establishment of the gasoline service station is beneficial to the general public and that the proposed site conforms with the list of permitted uses which require the issuance of a Special Use Permit as provided for under Ordinance No. SP-22, S-92, otherwise known as "The Quezon City Zoning Ordinance of 1992", and its Implementing Rules and Regulations authorizing the construction thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the issuance of a Special Use Permit to CALTEX (PHILIPPINES) INC., for the construction of a gasoline service station on the lot covered by Transfer Certificate of Title Numbered 368386 and 368387 located along G. Araneta Avenue, Quezon City.
