A RESOLUTION REQUESTING HIS HONOR, MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY TO POST REGULAR UNIFORMED TRAFFIC ENFORCERS AT THE ELLIPTICAL ROAD BETWEEN THE QUEZON MEMORIAL CIRCLE AND THE MAIN ENTRANCE OF THE QUEZON CITY HALL COMPOUND TO FACILITATE THE SMOOTH FLOW OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC AND ENSURE THE SAFE CROSSING OF PEDESTRIANS IN THE AREA.

WHEREAS, there is neither a pedestrian overpass nor traffic light in the Elliptical Road between the Quezon Memorial Circle and the main entrance of the Quezon City Hall posing great danger to pedestrians crossing the area specially during rush hours;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to ensure the safety and convenience of pedestrians, among others, city hall employees and people going to Quezon City Hall and Quezon Memorial Circle daily and other pedestrians crossing the accident prone area.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request, His Honor, Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to direct the Department of Public Order and Safety, to post regular uniformed traffic enforcers at the Elliptical Road between the Quezon Memorial Circle

and the main entrance of the Quezon City Hall compound to facilitate the smooth flow of vehicular traffic and ensure the safe crossing of pedestrians in the area.
