A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING QUEZON CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., THE QUEZON CITY TREASURER, AND ALL OTHER QUEZON CITY OFFICIALS, HAVING TO DO WITH THE REMITTANCES OF THE QUEZON CITY EMPLOYER-EMPLOYEES' CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE GOVERNMENT SERVICE INSURANCE SYSTEM (GSIS), PAG-IBIG AND PHILHEALTH, TO REGULARLY REMIT OR CAUSE THE REMITTANCE OF SAID CONTRIBUTIONS ON TIME WITHOUT FAIL, TO ASSURE THE PAYMENT AND AVAILABILITY OF ALL BENEFITS DUE TO SAID EMPLOYEES UNDER THE SYSTEM

WHEREAS, it is expressly mandated under the law that the agency shall regularly remit when they fall due, without delay under pain of penal and administrative sanctions, all employer-employee contributions to the GSIS, Pag-Ibig and Philhealth;

WHEREAS, the agency which delays remittance of such contributions is charged with interest of not less than two percent (2%) per month, hence, the obligation of the City to GSIS, Pag-Ibig and Philhealth grows and gradually increases in an amount corresponding to the length of time of such delay, which is undoubtedly grossly disadvantageous to the City;

WHEREAS, the employees premium contributions to GSIS, Pag-Ibig and Philhealth are regularly deducted from their respective salaries every pay day;


WHEREAS, said employees are adversely affected and grossly disadvantaged by the delay in the remittances of said contributions because they are unable to avail of the benefits due under the System, which make said none or delayed remittances as cause for the denial of the employees application for loan, or any other benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, Quezon City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., the Quezon City Treasurer, and all other Quezon City officials, having to do with the remittances of the Quezon City employer-employees' contributions to the Government Service Insurance System (GSIS), PAG-IBIG and PHILHEALTH, to regularly remit or cause the remittance of said contributions on time without fail, to assure the payment and availability of all benefits due to said employees under the System


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that all officials herein mentioned be furnished with a copy of this Resolution


