RESOLUTION NO. SP-1653, S-2001

A RESOLUTION URGING ALL QUEZON CITY COUNCILORS TO CONDUCT MARATHON INFORMATION DRIVES TO AVERT THE SPREAD OF DENGUE CASES IN THEIR RESPECTIVE AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY.

WHEREAS, the alarming outbreak of dengue cases nationwide, as reported by the Department of Health (DOH) lately, necessitates the undertaking of marathon information drives in the different barangays of Quezon City to avert the spread of dengue cases;

WHEREAS, through these marathon information drives, Quezon City residents will know all about the dengue fever disease, its symptoms, first aid treatment and related matters, as well as, identify, detect and destroy the breeding places of mosquitoes that are potential carriers of dengue and other diseases, especially during the rainy season which provides an abundance of stagnant water for their wholesale breeding;

WHEREAS, City Councilors can very well conduct marathon information drives in their respective areas of responsibility, in coordination with the Department of Health (DOH), barangay officials and non-government organizations (NGOs).

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, all Quezon City Councilors to conduct marathon information drives to avert the spread of dengue cases in their respective areas of responsibility.
