RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1658 S-2001

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BARANGAY COUNCILS OF QUEZON CITY TO GRANT INCENTIVE ALLOWANCE TO THEIR BARANGAY POOK LEADERS IN AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P500.00) BUT NOT LESS THAN TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200.00) EACH PER MONTH, IN RECOGNITION OF THEIR SERVICES TO THE COMMUNITY. THE AMOUNT NECESSARY FOR THE PURPOSE TO BE TAKEN FROM THE BARANGAY FUND.

WHEREAS, Pook Leaders have become important personages in the barangay level and vital partners in local governance;

WHEREAS, Pook Leaders have shown their worth not only in resolving personal disputes between Pook residents but more so in providing leadership in times of emergency and calamities;

WHEREAS, in recognition of their service to the community and as a token of their unselfishness, it is only proper that they be given an incentive reward.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, Barangay Councils of Quezon City to grant incentive allowance to their barangay Pook Leaders in an amount not exceeding Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) but should not be less than Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) each per month, in recognition of their services to the community.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that payment of the allowance shall be taken from the Barangay Fund and shall be subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
