RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1661 S-2001

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT OFFICE (CPDO) TO WAGE AN ALL-OUT WAR AGAINST ALL FORMS OF CRIMINALITY AND TERRORISM AND TO EFFECTIVELY STOP ALL FORMS OF ILLEGAL GAMBLING IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, news reports in television, radio, newspapers and other kinds of medium seem to indicate that crime has become a daily occurrence, perhaps because our law enforcers lack the necessary equipment, logistical and other support to fight lawbreakers and do what needs to be done to maintain peace and order;

WHEREAS, as elected officials, it is our honest desire to erase from the minds of our constituents a perception that they are being left alone in the midst of these uneasy times to defend themselves or to depend upon their own resources in safeguarding their persons and their homes;


WHEREAS, the Central Police District Office must show in no certain terms that they are not being remiss in their jobs, that they are in complete control of the peace and order situation and that the citizenry can go about without having to worry about their safety.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, the Central Police District Office (CPDO), to wage an all-out war against all forms of criminality and terrorism to effectively stop all forms of illegal gambling in Quezon City.
