A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE BANGKO SENTRAL NG PILIPINAS TO RE-DESIGN THE PHILIPPINE ONE HUNDRED PESO BILL BY ELIMINATING THEREFROM THE NATIONAL FLAG OF A FOREIGN COUNTRY.

WHEREAS, the present design of the Philippine One Hundred Peso bill shows on its face the presence of the national flag of a foreign country which is bigger in size and dimension and out shadows the Philippine flag;

WHEREAS, the picture of such flag of a foreign country in our monetary currency is an anathema to the concept of Philippine independence and freedom, and a grim reminder of the vestiges of colonialism and foreign domination which we all abhor.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas to re-design the Philippine One Hundred Peso bill by eliminating therefrom the national flag of a foreign country.
