RESOLUTION NO. SP 1674 S-2001

A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE CLARO A. ARELLANO, CITY PROSECUTOR OF QUEZON CITY, TO CREATE A SPECIAL PROSECUTION PANEL TO HANDLE COMPLAINTS AND PROSECUTION OF CASES FILED FOR VIOLATION OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-91, S-93, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE QUEZON CITY REVENUE CODE OF 1993; PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1096, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE NATIONAL BUILDING CODE; AND THE FIRE CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES.

WHEREAS, to prevent the happening of another devastating tragedy like the pre-dawn Manor Hotel fire which snuffed out the lives of at least 70 persons and injuring many others, the Honorable City Mayor FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., issued Executive Order No. 1, Series of 2001, creating ten (10) composite teams composed of three (3) members each from the following Departments:

1. Representative from the Fire Department
2. Representative from the Department of Public Order and Safety
3. Representative from the Engineering Department

to check, verify and inspect motels, hotels, apartelles, lodging houses, inns and hospitals within the jurisdiction of Quezon City in order to ensure compliance with the Quezon City Revenue Code, National Building Code and Fire Code of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, in order to expedite the filing of cases and prosecution of those persons who may be charged by the composite teams under Executive Order No. 1, etc., the need to create a special prosecution panel from the Office of the City Prosecutor is imperative.






