RESOLUTION NO. 1685, S-2001

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE HONORABLE MAYOR, FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO ATTY. ROGELIO U. CONCEPCION, WHO RETIRED AS PROSECUTOR III, (2ND ASSISTANT CITY PROSECUTOR) OF QUEZON CITY EFFECTIVE APRIL 26, 2000, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P150,000.00) TO BE TAKEN FROM THE APPROPRIATIONS OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR UNDER GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS IN THE CITY'S ANNUAL BUDGET FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2001.

WHEREAS, 2nd Assistant City Prosecutor Rogelio U. Concepcion, compulsorily retired having reached the age of sixty-five (65) years last April 26, 2000;

WHEREAS, Prosecutor Concepcion had rendered thirteen (13) years of continuous, dedicated, efficient and competent service as 2nd Assistant City Prosecutor in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, prior to his appointment as 2nd Assistant City Prosecutor, he served seven (7) years as acting 2nd Assistant City Prosecutor, four (4) years as acting 5th Assistant City Fiscal, two (2) years as 6th Assistant Fiscal, and five (5) years as 7th Assistant Fiscal, all in Quezon City;


WHEREAS, Prosecutor Concepcion had earned forty (40) years of government service, starting as a modest helper, then Computer I to Legal Officer and finally as Trial Attorney in the Bureau of Printing, Department of General Services;

WHEREAS, such request is consistent with the policy of the City Council, this City of giving financial assistance to dedicated, loyal and deserving Prosecutors of Quezon City.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request, His Honor, City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to grant financial assistance to Atty. Rogelio U. Concepcion, who retired as 2nd Assistant City Prosecutor of Quezon City effective April 26, 2000, in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P150,000.00) to be taken from the appropriations of the Office of the City Mayor under grants, subsidies and contributions in the City's Annual Budget for calendar year 2001.
