RESOLUTION NO. SP-1691 S-2001

A RESOLUTION URGING THE OFFICE OF SENIOR CITIZENS AFFAIRS (OSCA) TO TAKE CHARGE IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7432, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE SENIOR CITIZENS LAW, THE GRANT OF MANDATORY DISCOUNT OF TWENTY PERCENT (20%) TO SENIOR CITIZENS.

WHEREAS, the Senior Citizens Law, Republic Act No. 7432 provides for the grant of a mandatory discount of twenty percent (20%) to senior citizens by business establishments;

WHEREAS, it has been reported that certain business establishments and transportation companies do not comply with the mandate of the law by refusing to honor valid Senior Citizen Identification cards issued by the Quezon City government;

WHEREAS, Quezon City must give special attention to its elderly citizens whose earning capacity has been greatly diminished by their condition by protecting their rights under the Senior Citizens Law.

NOW, THEREFORE,




