RESOLUTION NO. SP-1693, S-2001

A RESOLUTION URGING BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS OPERATING IN QUEZON CITY TO ACCEPT AND ACCOMMODATE AT LEAST ONE HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE APPLICANT FOR JOB TRAINING AND APPRENTICESHIP WHO IS A RESIDENT OF QUEZON CITY, WHERE SUCH BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS ARE CAPABLE OF EXTENDING SUCH TRAINING.

WHEREAS, *there are many high school graduates, particularly those residing in Quezon City, who are unable, for one reason or another, to pursue higher college education;*

WHEREAS, *with their secondary education as their only tool in looking for a job, they find it difficult to secure any employment in both the government and the private sector;*

WHEREAS, *there is a felt need for said high school graduates to further undergo job training and acquire experience in actual work settings in order for them to sharpen their skills and knowledge in particular areas of endeavor which will be their passport in applying for employment;*

WHEREAS, *there is a need for local government intervention and the cooperation of private business establishments in order to attain the foregoing objectives.*


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, business establishments operating in Quezon City to accept and accommodate at least one (1) high school graduate applicant residing in Quezon City for job training and apprenticeship in a given year, where such business establishments are capable of extending such training. Said trainee shall be extended the privilege and opportunity of learning and acquiring knowledge and experience in the particular area of endeavor on which he is interested and could be learned in said business establishment, through on-the-job training.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, to urge said business establishments to grant said on-the-job trainee such wages, or other emoluments as the owner of the business establishment may deem proper, for humanitarian consideration, commensurate with his work output redounding to the benefit of his business.

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, to authorize the Chief of the Quezon City Business Permits and Licensing Office, in coordination with the Quezon City Division of City Schools' Superintendent to issue the necessary guidelines, rules and regulations for the implementation of this Resolution.


