RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1695 S-2001

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY COUNCIL TO GRANT ADDITIONAL FRANCHISE TO THE TWENTY (20) PETITIONERS FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLE FOR HIRE PLYING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF BARANGAY OLD CAPITOL SITE AND BARANGAY SAN VICENTE.

Introduced by Councilors ALMARIO E. FRANCISCO, JESUS "Bong" C. SUNTAY, ALMA F. MONTILLA, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., JANET M. MALAYA, RICARDO R. DEL ROSARIO, RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN, ERIC Z. MEDINA, ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE and ROMMEL R. ABESAMIS.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government considers the importance of an efficient and affordable transportation facility as a basic necessity, which must always be made available to the public;

WHEREAS, intermittent operations are being conducted occasionally against colorum tricycle plying within Barangay Old Capitol Site;

WHEREAS, aside from the apparent harassment being experienced by the drivers of colorum tricycles, the operations against them from time to time have become sources of graft and corruption committed by some of those conducting such operations;

WHEREAS, the grant of franchises to the petitioners and the consequential legalization will dramatically diminish the incidents of graft and corruption in this sector of society, particularly in Barangay Old Capitol Site;

WHEREAS, the need for a more responsive transport service as opposed to the ever-growing population of the barangay and the outlying ones will be achieved.


NOW, THEREFORE,


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished the concerned barangay and other offices concerned for information and ready reference.
