RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1704 , S-2001

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS PADRE GOMEZ ASSEMBLY FOR THE USE OF A ONE HUNDRED FIFTY (150) SQUARE METER CITY-OWNED PROPERTY FOR NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS (NGO) MULTI-PURPOSE SERVICE CENTER.

WHEREAS, Section 34, Chapter 4 of Republic Act 7160 provides that "Role of People's and Non-governmental Organizations - Local government unit shall promote the establishment and operation of people's and non-governmental organizations to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy";

WHEREAS, in pursuance of City Resolution No. SP-1346, S-2000, a Memorandum of Agreement was executed by and between Quezon City, represented by former Mayor Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., and the Knights of Columbus Padre Gomez Assembly for the use by the latter of a One Hundred Fifty (150) square meter City government property at the NGO's Center in Roces Avenue;

WHEREAS, the establishment of the Non-Governmental Organizations Multi-Purpose Community Service Center is aimed at providing assistance, in coordination with the Quezon City government, on youth and sports development, manpower and livelihood training, health care and other related services/activities that will help improve the living conditions of the people and enhance their well-being, especially those who have less in life.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify, the Memorandum of Agreement by and between the Quezon City Government, and the Knights of Columbus Padre Gomez Assembly, for the use of a One Hundred Fifty (150) square meter city-owned property at the NGO Center, Roces Avenue, as a Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) Multi-Purpose Service Center acknowledged before Atty. Manuel F. De Jesus, Notary Public, and appearing in his Notarial Registry book under Doc. No. 482, Page No. 106, Book No. II, Series of 2000.


