RESOLUTION NO. SP1707 S-2001

A RESOLUTION CREATING A SUB-COMMITTEE THAT WILL STUDY AND SUBMIT RECOMMENDATIONS ON HOW TO IMPROVE THE REVENUE GENERATING CAPABILITY OF THE 1993 REVENUE CODE OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the existence of sufficient funds is necessary to achieve a well functioning and acceptable city governance;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Revenue Code of 1993 is the instrument by which the City can raise and provide the necessary funds for a well functioning and achieving City Administration;

WHEREAS, although the present Quezon City Revenue Code has provided the necessary revenues that has achieved the expected governance and services for the City for the past seven (7) years, it can still accept improvements and changes to be a more effective tool for a better government which the inhabitants of the City deserve;

WHEREAS, the new administration that was ushered in by the just concluded May 2001 election needs the full unequivocal support of the different sectors of the civil society in Quezon City, especially the support of the Quezon City Council, a body that is tasked to formulate policies for good governance;

WHEREAS, the City Council, as the policy making and legislative arm of the City, can create meaningful policies with regards to the matters of raising revenues for delivery of basic services to the community;

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WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council, pursuant to Section 12 of its Internal Rules may create a Sub-Committee that can make a study on how to provide the present Revenue Code with a new and improved collection techniques in increasing revenues which, in turn, can provide a better government and accelerate the delivery of basic services for the City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to create, as it does hereby create, a Sub-Committee to be composed of the following:

- a. Chairman, Committee on Ways and Means
- b. President Pro-Tempore
- c. Majority Floor Leader
- d. Minority Floor Leader
- e. Chairman, Committee on Trade, Commerce and Industry
- f. Chairman, Committee on Appropriations
- g. Any member of the City Council duly appointed by the Council will be part of the Sub-Committee created by this resolution.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the selected members of the Sub-Committee shall, among themselves, elect a Chairman and Vice Chairman and shall function in accordance with the existing internal rules of procedures of the City Council;

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, that the elected Chairman of the Committee is authorized to make representations with the Honorable City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., for sourcing of funds to defray the necessary expenses of the Sub-Committee;

RESOLVED, FURTHERSTILL, that the Sub-Committee shall make a study and submit recommendations on how to improve the fund raising capability of the 1993 Revenue Code of the City;

RESOLVED, FURTHERSTILL, that the Sub-Committee is hereby authorized to call upon any of the city officials, officers and/or employees to assist in the performance of its functions and for this purpose may create a Technical Committee to be taken from among said officials, officers and/or employees of the city;


RESOLVED, FURTHERSTILL, that the Committee shall, within 60 days from its formal organizations, submit its report to the Quezon City Council.






