RESOLUTION NO. SP-1709, S-2001

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO INITIATE AND CONDUCT, OR CAUSE TO BE CONDUCTED, A MANAGEMENT AUDIT OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, TO STREAMLINE ITS STRUCTURAL ORGANIZATION, AVOID FUNCTIONAL OVERLAPS, MINIMIZE COST, PROMOTE EFFICIENCY AND EFFECTIVENESS, AND IMPROVE THE DELIVERY OF BASIC PUBLIC SERVICES

WHEREAS, in the course of time, the City government of Quezon City had grown big, while its personnel and employees have considerably increased in number;

WHEREAS, many departments, offices, bureaus, boards, services, councils, committees and task forces have been created requiring at the same time the creation of corresponding positions, thereby increasing the size of the bureaucracy;

WHEREAS, the unrestrained creation of positions may have resulted in various functional overlaps in some areas, excesses far beyond the requirements of efficient and effective management;


WHEREAS, the need for a management audit of the Quezon City government was strongly felt during the time of Mayor Norberto Amoranto where he spearheaded a move for a management audit of the Quezon City government. However, for one reason or another, the result thereof could not be properly implemented;

WHEREAS, since then, the Quezon City bureaucracy had tremendously increased in size and grown to huge proportions, such that there is an imperative need to re-examine, review and reassess its present status, having in mind to streamline its organizational structure and personnel complement, to keep attuned to the exigencies of the service.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, the City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to initiate and conduct, or cause to be conducted, a management audit of the Quezon City government to streamline its structural organization, avoid functional overlaps, minimize cost, promote efficiency and effectiveness, and improve the delivery of basic public services.
