RESOLUTION NO. SP-1712, S-2001

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING MRT MANAGEMENT TO DEFER ITS DECISION TO CONSTRUCT ONE METER HIGH CONCRETE CENTER ISLAND ALONG AURORA BOULEVARD, CUBAO, QUEZON CITY, DUE TO ITS ADVERSE EFFECT TO RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES SPROUTING IN THE AREA AND INSTEAD ADOPT AN ALTERNATIVE VIABLE SCHEME BENEFICIAL TO ALL SECTORS.

WHEREAS, the construction of MRT along Aurora Boulevard, Cubao, Quezon City is one way of easing traffic congestion, such should not become a hindrance to economic growth, and community development;

WHEREAS, while other government agencies are busy finding ways to promote growth and development of small enterprises in the country, other projects and programs instituted by the national government should be in harmony thereof, by giving due regard to existing businesses;

WHEREAS, residents and businessmen in the area are now in quandary and too much worried about the future effects, this one meter concrete center island may offer when constructed along Aurora Boulevard, Cubao, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, explicitly requires all national agencies and offices to conduct periodic consultations with appropriate local government units, non-governmental and people's organizations and other concerned sectors of the community before any project or program is implemented in their respective jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, there are concerned sectors in the area who are voicing their appeal to defer or reconsider the decision of MRT Management to construct one meter high concrete center island for Aurora Boulevard, Cubao, Quezon City, raising the ground that it is not conducive, appropriate and relevant to business environment.



NOW, THEREFORE


