A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. WHEREAS, there are number of designated tourist spots in Quezon City, yet very little information is known about them;


WHEREAS, through the aid of pamphlets, brochures, posters, billboards, books, compact discs and other related materials, the City government would be able to promote local tourism;

WHEREAS, there is a need to promote local tourism in order to encourage investments to come in and increase the City's revenues.


NOW, THEREFORE,
