RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1714 S-2001

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY DIRECTING THE CHIEF AND THE INSPECTORS OF THE BUSINESS PERMITS AND LICENSING OFFICE (BPLO) TO STRICTLY ENFORCE THE PROVISION OF ARTICLE 22, SECTION 83 IN RELATION TO SECTION 85 OF THE QUEZON CITY REVENUE CODE OF 1993 TO THE EFFECT THAT IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO EXERCISE HIS OCCUPATION OR CALLING WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY, WITHOUT ACQUIRING THE INDIVIDUAL MAYOR'S PERMIT.

WHEREAS, it has been observed that many business establishments employ persons without the Mayor's Permit and thereby making them open to abuse and threat;

WHEREAS, Section 83 of the Quezon City Revenue Code provided that "it shall be unlawful for any person to exercise his occupation or calling within the jurisdiction of the city without acquiring the individual Mayor's permit";

WHEREAS, owners, operators and/or managers of business establishments should be responsible in seeing to it that their employees have already acquired the necessary Mayor's permit before they employ them for work in their respective business establishments.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to direct, as it does hereby direct, the Chief and the Inspectors of Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) to strictly enforce the provision of Article 22, Section 83 in relation to Section 85 of the Quezon City Revenue Code of 1993 to the effect that it shall be unlawful for any person to exercise his occupation or calling within the jurisdiction of the city without acquiring the individual Mayor's Permit.
