A RESOLUTION REQUESTING HIS HONOR, MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO URGE AND/OR MAKE PROPER REPRESENTATION WITH THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT AND/OR THE APPROPRIATE GOVERNMENT AGENCY FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PEDESTRIAN OVER-PASS/WALK-WAY ACROSS QUIRINO HIGHWAY FROM BARANGAY STA. MONICA TO NOVALICHES PROPER.

WHEREAS, the busiest pedestrian intersection in Novaliches Proper from across Barangay Sta. Monica along Quirino Highway has caused not only traffic congestion but also inconvenience and danger to pedestrians, motorists, and the general public;

WHEREAS, the existing infrastructure in the said area limits the expansion of the road network and its adjacent sidewalks;


WHEREAS, the only way to resolve and thereby ease the congestion and the flow of both the vehicular and pedestrian movement is the construction of an above-ground pedestrian over-pass/walk-way.


agency for the establishment of a pedestrian over-pass/walk-way across Quirino Highway from Barangay Sta. Monica to Novaliches proper.
