RESOLUTION NO. SP- **1724** , S-2002

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE HONORABLE MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE TRICYCLE REGULATORY UNIT (TRU) TO AMEND THE IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES LIMITING THE NUMBER OF PASSENGERS TO THREE (3), INCLUDING THE DRIVER.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-15, Series of 1992 provides in Section 13, paragraph F to wit:

"NO MOTORIZED TRICYCLE SHALL BE ALLOWED TO CARRY MORE PASSENGERS AND/OR GOODS THAN IT IS DESIGNED FOR."

WHEREAS, pursuant to the foregoing ordinance, the Tricycle Regulatory Unit, through the Office of the Mayor, adopted in its implementing guidelines in item No. 5 of the Rules and Regulations of the Motorized Tricycle Operator's Permit (MTOF), that:

"THE PASSENGER CAPACITY OF THE SINGLE WHEELED SIDECAR/TRICYCLE SHALL BE LIMITED TO THREE (3) ONLY, INCLUDING DRIVER."

WHEREAS, the said policy guideline is no longer realistic as well as practical to date, considering the present motor strength capacity of tricycles for hire plying the streets so as to accommodate more of the riding public. Also, the sidecar is so designed that it can accommodate more than three (3) passengers inside plus the back ride on the motorcycle itself.

WHEREAS, it is also of public knowledge that tricycle drivers are accommodating passengers more than the number allowed by the guidelines;


WHEREAS, upon representation of the Culiat TODA officers through a resolution hereto attached, it is imperative to amend the aforesaid policy guideline, thru this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, the Honorable Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to amend said implementing guidelines by increasing the number of passengers to maximum of five (5) passengers, including driver, Provided the motorcycle is designed to carry such number of passengers and; Provided, Further, that the safety of the passengers shall be the prime consideration in adopting this amendment.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Honorable City Mayor, through the Tricycle Regulatory Unit (TRU) for appropriate action.
