RESOLUTION NO. SP 1726, 2002

A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION PESOS (P2,000,000.00) FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY MAYOR FOR THE REPAIR AND TOTAL REHABILITATION OF STREET SIGNS IN ALL STREET CORNERS AND MAIN THOROUGHFARES IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, it has been observed that street signs along the main thoroughfares in the City and its adjacent streets are in poor and dilapidated conditions and in some cases, others have been detached, destroyed and lost;

WHEREAS, these street signs are useful guide to motorists and pedestrians and could save them the time and effort in locating certain address;


WHEREAS, pursuant to the cleanliness and beautification program of the administration, the much needed rehabilitation of street signs will be timely.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to allocate, as it does hereby allocate, the amount of Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.000) from any available funds of the City Mayor for the repair and total rehabilitation of street signs in all street corners and main thoroughfares in the City.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the street signs should include the name of the barangay and district for the convenience of motorists and pedestrians alike.


