RESOLUTION NO. SP **1728** S-2002

RESOLUTION EARNESTLY URGING THE METROPOLITAN WATERWORKS AND SEWERAGE SYSTEM (MWSS) ADMINISTRATION TO CONSIDER CONVERTING A CERTAIN AREA IN THE FILTRATION GROUNDS INTO A QUEZON CITY YOUTH CAMP.

WHEREAS, the Balara Filtration ground is of historical significance to the scouting movement in the country as the site of the First Boy Scout of the Philippines National Jamboree in 1954;

WHEREAS, the subject site, consisting of the grounds surrounding the filtration area, the swimming pools and surrounding pavilions is an ideal venue for a youth camp which would serve as a laboratory school of the Scouts in their pursuit of their merit badge program;

WHEREAS, as a Youth Camp, the area would be developed and preserved for its ecological value, enhancing the integrity of the place as a watershed.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby earnestly urge, the administration of the Metropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage System (MWSS) to consider converting a certain area in the filtration grounds in its Balara filters facilities in Balara, Quezon City, into a Youth Camp to be jointly managed with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Quezon City Council, with financial support from the Quezon City government.






