RESOLUTION NO. SP-**1732**, S-2002

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CHIEF OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE, DIRECTOR GENERAL LEANDRO MENDOZA, TO IMPOSE MORE STRINGENT REQUIREMENTS BEFORE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES TO PRIVATE SECURITY GUARDS.

Introduced by Councilors JORGE L. BANAL, JULIAN M.L. COSETENG, ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, VINCENT P. CRISOLOGO, VOLTAIRE GODOFRIDO L. LIBAN III, ERIC Z. MEDINA, JESUS "Bong" C. SUNTAY, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., JANET M. MALAYA and RESTITUTO B. MALANGEN.

WHEREAS, there is a rash of criminal activities especially those committed against persons and drug-related crimes;

WHEREAS, the Philippine National Police is undermanned and ill-equipped to address fully the problems of criminality;

WHEREAS, to augment and complement the Philippine National Police Force, private security guards are hired to provide security to business establishments, private residential buildings and the people therein;

WHEREAS, there is a public perception that the issuance of licenses to private security guards are expedited by special favors;

WHEREAS, Nida Blanca's killer/s saw the opportunity to perpetuate the crime due to security lapses ;

WHEREAS, it is the primordial duty of the State to protect its people.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Chief of the Philippine National Police, Director General Leandro Mendoza, to impose more stringent requirements for the issuance of licenses to private security guards
