A RESOLUTION OFFICIALLY DECLARING THE WHOLE 3-STOREY QUEZON CITY HALL LEGISLATIVE WING AS QUEZON CITY LEGISLATIVE BUILDING FOR THE EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT AND ALLIED LEGISLATIVE OFFICES.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Council Resolution No. SP-21, S-92 the General Services Office has been transferring non-legislative offices out of the Legislative Building.


NOW, THEREFORE,


