RESOLUTION NO. SP 1755, s-2002

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE HONORABLE MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE AUGUST 28, 2001 VICTIMS OF FIRE THAT BURNED THE RESIDENTIAL HOUSES OF, MORE OR LESS, THIRTY (30) FAMILIES AT BARANGAY DEL MONTE, AREA IV, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER, WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE SOURCE OF FUND THEREOF.

WHEREAS, on August 28, 2001, Barangay Del Monte, specifically Del Monte Avenue corner West Riverside Street was hit by fire that burned the houses of, more or less, thirty (30) families who are now in dire need of financial assistance most especially from the City government;

WHEREAS, because of this calamity, they are now experiencing difficulties in life;

WHEREAS, it is the primary duty of the City government to extend assistance to its less fortunate constituents.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, the Honorable Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to extend financial assistance to the August 28, 2001 victims of fire that burned the residential houses of, more or less, thirty (30) families at Barangay Del Monte, Area IV, District I, Quezon City, at Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) per family owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per family renter/sharee, which shall be taken from the calamity or emergency fund of the City government or from any available source of fund thereof.
