RESOLUTION NO. SP 1757, S-2002

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO LOOK INTO THE FEASIBILITY OF ASSIGNING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY (DPOS) THE TASK OF GUARDING CITY HALL AND OTHER PUBLIC BUILDINGS OWNED BY THE CITY GOVERNMENT ON A 24 HOUR BASIS AND TO LET THE PRIVATE SECURITY AGENCIES UNDERTAKE SUCH RESPONSIBILITY FROM 6:00 P.M. TO 6:00 A.M.

WHEREAS, the city government is presently spending P25,337,750 annually to pay the private security agencies guarding City Hall and other public buildings owned by the city government on a 24-hour basis;

WHEREAS, the city government has an agency, the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS), which can probably undertake such responsibility during the day and thus reduce substantially the amount allocated to the private security agencies;

WHEREAS, should it be found feasible for the DPOS to undertake the job, its personnel should be provided with proper and identifiable uniforms.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request, the City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to look into the feasibility of assigning to the Department of Public Order and Safety the task of guarding City Hall and other public buildings owned by the city government on a 24 hour basis and to let the private security agencies undertake such responsibility from 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
