RESOLUTION NO. SP-1768-2002

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER WITHOUT COST OF THIRTY SEVEN (37) UNITS ASIAN UTILITY VEHICLES (AUVS) AND MOTORCYCLES TO DISTRICT III BARANGAYS AND THE DISTRICT III OFFICE AND TO TURN-OVER ALL DOCUMENTS PERTAINING THERETO.

Introduced by Councilors JESUS "BONG" C. SUNTAY, JORGE L. BANAL, JULIAN M.L. COSETENG, FRANZ S. PUMAREN, WENCEROM BENEDICT C. LAGUMBAY, DIORELLA MARIA G. SOTTO-DE LEON and DANTE M. DE GUZMAN.

WHEREAS, the barangay as the basic political unit, serves as the primary planning and implementing unit of government policies, plans, programs, projects and activities in the community;

WHEREAS, to effectively carry out the functions and objectives of the barangay, more particularly in the maintenance of peace and order in the community, it is indispensable that these barangays are provided with modes of transportation;

WHEREAS, the thirty seven (37) units AUVs and motorcycles distributed to the different District III barangays and the District III Office were coursed to the City General Services Office under former Congressman Michael Defensor's Trust Fund, and payment for insurance and registration are undertaken by the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, considering that these vehicles are being utilized by the District III barangays, it is imperative that all pertinent documents such as, Certificates of Registration, Official Receipts, Certificates of Cover and stencils be turned over to said barangays under the responsibility of the incumbent Congresswoman of the Third District, Hon. Maite Defensor. The insurance and registration therefor shall be borne by the Congresswoman's office.


NOW, THEREFORE




