RESOLUTION NO. SP 1770, S-2002

A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF THE LATE SPO2 RAFAEL M. MEDINA, A MEMBER OF THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT OFFICE (CPDO), QUEZON CITY, IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) TO BE TAKEN FROM THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002.

WHEREAS, on September 18, 1995, while in line of duty, SPO2 Rafael M. Medina suffered cerebrovascular disease (hemorrhage) which resulted in his untimely demise. At the time of his death, he had rendered twenty-six (26) years of faithful, dedicated and loyal service to the people of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, due to his death, his family is experiencing so much difficulty, both emotionally and financially, as their life savings were all gone to medical and funeral services;

WHEREAS, in recognition of his valuable contribution to the maintenance of peace and order in Quezon City, it is but fitting and proper to grant his bereaved family financial assistance pursuant to Section 3 of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-154, S-94, that members of the Central Police District Command (CPDC) who die or suffer from total and permanent disability or incapacity in line of duty regardless of length of police service are entitled to financial assistance by way of additional death or disability benefit in the amount of Thirty Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00).
