RESOLUTION NO. SP-1775, S-2002

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE HONORABLE MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE APRIL 16 VICTIMS OF FIRE CONSISTING OF FORTY (40) FAMILIES WHOSE RESIDENTIAL HOUSES WERE BURNED AT BARANGAY STA. TERESITA, AREA VI, DISTRICT 1, QUEZON CITY, AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER, WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE SOURCE OF FUND THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE,




