RESOLUTION NO. SP-1777 S-2002

A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE VICTIMS OF THE FIRE THAT OCCURRED IN AREA VI (NISSAN), BARANGAY TATALON, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, ON NOVEMBER 2, 2001, THE AMOUNT TO BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, an unfortunate event occurred in Area VI (Nissan), Bgy. Tatalon, District IV, when a fire swept over the area on November 2, 2001 burning to the ground some houses of residents therein;

WHEREAS, the city government has always shown its compassion to the victims in their hour of need.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, financial assistance to the victims of the fire that occurred in Area VI (Nissan), Barangay Tatalon, District IV, Quezon City, on November 2, 2001, the amount to be taken from the Calamity or Emergency Fund of the city government or from any available funds in the City Treasury, as follows:

Four (4) Homeowners	---	P4,000.00 each
Eleven (11) Renters	---	2,000.00 each





RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Social Services Development Department shall validate and authenticate the list of the fire victims categorized into house owners and house renters and to submit the same to the Office of the City Mayor, with representation for the early release of the financial assistance to the qualified recipients.

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, that the Office of the Mayor shall revalidate and confirm the list submitted by the Social Services Development Department which shall be the basis for the preparation of the payroll and shall approve the immediate release of the funds allocated for this purpose.
