
A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING QUEZON CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR. TO IMPLEMENT OR CAUSE THE IMPLEMENTATION IN QUEZON CITY OF R.A. 9003, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT OF 2000," PARTICULARLY ON THE MANDATORY SEGREGATION OF SOLID WASTE, THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE QUEZON CITY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD, AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE QUEZON CITY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN.



WHEREAS, the collection and proper disposal of garbage has grown into a perennial problem in Metro Manila, including Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Congress has enacted into law R.A. 9003, otherwise known as the "Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000," which provides for an integrated and comprehensive system of waste and garbage collection and disposal, involving the active participation of a wide range of government agencies, officialdom, and the private sector, including local government units down to the level of the barangays;

WHEREAS, it is expressly provided in said R.A. 9003 that the local government units shall be responsible for the implementation of its provisions in their respective jurisdictions;





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WHEREAS, said law likewise provides for the establishment of Provincial, City and Municipal Solid Waste Management Boards, and the development of local government unit solid waste management plans;

WHEREAS, the law further provides, that the "segregation and collection of solid waste shall be conducted at the barangay level specifically for biodegradable, compostable and reusable waste" and that "the collection of non-recyclable materials and special wastes shall be the responsibility of the municipality or city;"

WHEREAS, the proper implementation of R.A. 9003 within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City will doubtless go a long way to promote our health, cleanliness and sanitation program.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, the Quezon City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to implement or cause the implementation in Quezon City of R.A. 9003, otherwise known as the "Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000", particularly on the mandatory segregation of solid waste, the establishment of the Quezon City Solid Waste Management Board, and the development of the Quezon City Solid Waste Management Plan.
