A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE TEN (10) FAMILIES WHOSE HOUSES ARE TO BE DEMOLISHED AND RELOCATED FROM KATIPUNAN EXT., BARANGAY BAGBAG, DISTRICT II, QUEZON CITY, TO BARANGAY TALIPAPA, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, houses of some ten (10) families are scheduled to be demolished to give way for the construction of Katipunan Road in Barangay Bagbag;

WHEREAS, it is the City's policy, manifested in previous similar cases, to extend financial assistance to city residents affected by government infrastructure developments as a form of humanitarian consideration to ease the hardship of their situation and to facilitate the relocation;

WHEREAS, the subject (10) families are of economic class in the need of city assistance


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to extend financial assistance to the ten (10) families whose houses are to be demolished and relocated from Katipunan Ext. Barangay Bagbag, District II, Quezon City to Barangay Talipapa, Quezon City, in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Pesos (P15, 000.00) per family, amounting to One Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P150,000.00).
