RESOLUTION NO. SP **1793**S-2002

A RESOLUTION URGING HIS HONOR, MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) TO THE FAMILY OF THE LATE SPO1 AQUILINO R. ABIT, A FORMER MEMBER OF THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT COMMAND (CPDC), PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP), THE AMOUNT TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS IN THE 2002 ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR.

WHEREAS, SPO1 Aquilino R. Abit had been a policeman for more than twenty two (22) years and was assigned at the Central Police District Command (CPDC), Philippine National Police (PNP) from July 16, 1978 until his untimely death on December 23, 2000;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3 of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-154, S-94, members of the Central Police District Command (CPDC) who die or suffer from total and permanent disability or incapacity in line of duty regardless of length of police service are entitled to financial assistance by way of additional death or disability benefit in the amount of Thirty Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00).


